

WHAT DOES Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account with us or apply for a loan • Make deposits in accounts or withdrawals from accounts • Give us your income information or employment history We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. [See below for more on your rights under state law.]
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>None</i>
Nonaffiliates	<i>Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <i>Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC does not jointly market.</i>
Other important information	
Do Not Call Policy: This notice is the Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC (affiliates) Do Not Call Policy under the Telephone Consumer Protection Act. We do not solicit via phone numbers listed on the state or federal Do Not Call lists, unless the law permits. Consumers who ask not to receive telephone solicitations from Boulevard Specialty Lending (and affiliates) will be placed on the Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC Do Not Call list and will not be called in any future solicitations, including those of Boulevard Specialty Lending Affiliates. If you communicate with us by telephone, we may monitor or record the call.

For Nevada residents only. We are providing you this notice pursuant to state law. Vermont: In accordance with Vermont law, we will not share information we collect about Vermont residents with companies outside of our corporate family, except as permitted by law, such as with your consent, to service your accounts or to other financial institutions with which we have joint marketing agreements. We will not share information about your creditworthiness within our corporate family except with your authorization or consent, but we may share information about our transactions or experiences with you within our corporate family with your consent

California: In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information to service your accounts, or to provide rewards or benefits you are entitled to. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extent required by California law. We collect personally identifiable information from online customers when those customers choose to enter their personal information while using Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC’s web sites and/or online services (including mobile applications). This information includes, but is not limited to, customer names, email and mailing addresses, phone numbers, and social security numbers. Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC does not collect personally identifiable information from general online site visitors unless those consumers unilaterally opt to provide personally identifiable information to Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC. Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC also does not share personally identifiable information with third-party persons or entities unless authorized by the customer.

If Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC’s online customers wish to change the contents of the personally identifiable information previously supplied to Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC, those customers may do so by contacting their local Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC office and requesting the change. Alternatively, some web sites and online services offered by Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC permit customers to change the contents of their personally identifiable information online.

As stated above, Boulevard Specialty Lending does not collect personally identifiable information about individual consumers unless those consumers choose to provide such information. We are aware that some internet browsers have incorporated Do Not Track (“DNT”) features. Most of these features, when turned on send a signal or preference to the web sites you visit indicating that you do not wish to be tracked. Because Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC does not collect personally identifiable information unless the online customer voluntarily submits it, and because of a lack of industry standard, Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC does not currently respond to DNT signals, whether on its web sites or other online services.

Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC does not allow other parties to collect personally identifiable information about its online customers’ individual online activities over time or across different web sites. Boulevard Specialty Lending, LLC cannot, however, guarantee protection from web-based criminal conduct that could result in the collection of an online customer’s personally identifiable information by an outside party.

For Insurance Customers in AZ, CA, CT, GA, IL, ME, MA, MN, MT, NV, NJ, NC, OH, OR, and VA only. The term “information” in this part means customer information obtained in an insurance transaction. We may give your information to state insurance officials, law enforcement, group policy holders about claims experience, or auditors as the law allows or requires. We may give your information to insurance support companies that may keep it or give it to others. We may share medical information so we can learn if you qualify for coverage, process claims, or prevent fraud or if you say we can. To see your information, contact the employee who services your account by mail or telephone. You must state your full name, address, the insurance company, policy number (if relevant), and the information you want. We will tell you what information we have. You may see and copy the information (unless privileged) at our office or ask that we mail you a copy for a fee. If you think any information is wrong, you must write us. We will let you know what actions we take. If you do not agree with our actions, you may send us a statement.

For MA Insurance Customers only. You may ask in writing the specific reasons for an adverse underwriting decision. An adverse underwriting decision is where we decline your application for insurance, offer to insure you at a higher than standard rate, or terminate your coverage.
